



Get Board Certified in Hemostasis Nursing!

What is the Hemostasis Nursing Board Certification?

The <u>Hemostasis Nursing board certification through portfolio</u>, a unique credential from the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC), is designed specifically for registered nurses in hemostasis nursing! It provides a valid and reliable assessment of the clinical knowledge and skills of registered nurses in the hemostasis nursing specialty. The credential, *Registered Nurse-Board Certified (RN-BC)*, is valid for 5 years.

What Do I Have to Do?

Eligible applicants submit an online portfolio of evidence to document their specialized knowledge, skills, understanding, and application of professional nursing practice and theory. No written exam is required. Once you successfully pass the portfolio review process, you are awarded the credential.

STEP 1: Confirm Eligibility and Pricing

- Eligibility criteria and pricing information can be found on the Hemostasis Nursing website.
- You may be eligible for a subsidy to cover the Application Fee! *Partners in Bleeding Disorders Education* will reimburse a *significant* portion of the application fee of successful candidates working with patients with bleeding disorders and employed at a federally recognized hemophilia treatment center. STEP 2: Prepare Portfolio & Apply Online

- **Download** and carefully read the <u>CERTIFICATION THROUGH PORTFOLIO APPLICATION</u> <u>REQUIREMENTS</u>. This gives you a step-by-step "to-do" list.
- **Download** and carefully read the <u>PORTFOLIO CONTENT OUTLINE</u>. This explains the 4 domains that will be evaluated in your portfolio and their corresponding weights.
- **Read** the <u>PORTFOLIO PREPARATION TIPS</u> for helpful hints on how to apply.
