Course Description

Developed by HTC educators for HTC educators, the *Presentation Skills Workshop* is hosted once per year and provides a unique training opportunity for HTC providers looking to improve their presentation delivery skills in order to:

- Manage anxiety and energy during a presentation
- Create and structure a focused presentation
- Use transitions and "alerts" to facilitate the learning process
- Incorporate feedback from peers to improve presentation skills
- Deliver a presentation that interests and engages the audience
- Open and close a presentation with strength
- Comfortably manage questions from the audience

Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- 1. Be a current employee of a HTC or affiliate*
- 2. Submit the Presentation Skills Workshop application and supporting materials
- Have at least two years' experience as a professional in the HTC network
- 4. Substantiate professional experience in curriculum vitae or resume
- 5. Demonstrate a need or desire to improve presentation skills
- Have experience in public speaking and/or educational program delivery, or demonstrate need to develop public speaking and/or educational program delivery skills
